Council objects to proposed housing development at Peat Carr

Hetton Town Council has lodged a formal objection to plans for a new residential development on a greenfield site at Cragdale Gardens, Peat Carr.

At its' September meetings, Town Councillors heard residents strong concerns about the plans and the likely impact it would have.

Councillor Kay Rowham, Chairman of the Council's Planning and Development Committee said "The Council has listened to residents and share their concerns about the threat to green space and the potential effects on traffic congestion, parking, and additional pressures on local schools and health services."

Lynsey Gibson, a local resident and an organiser of a petition opposing the plans added "Residents are against this development and the loss of a well used green space."

The Town Council has now written to Sunderland City Council outlining its views. The City Council will consider all views received when the planning application is formally determined.
